While in New York on business, Walt Disney kept hearing a novelty song, "Chi-Baba Chi-Baba," played on the radio and hired its three composers to write for *Cinderella*. Little surprise then that this similar song appeared in the film and became a hit single, most notably for Perry Como & The Fontane Sisters.

Hints & Tips: Practice the R.H. alone in measures 1-4. Note the triplet rhythms and the accidentals. Plan your fingering. These measures are repeated again in measures 5-8, and again (with a different ending) in measures 13-16.
