Ernest F. Wagner (ca. 1870-1954) was an American flutist, author and teacher. He served as a performing member of the famous John Philip Sousa band from 1915-17. Wagner's reputation as a successful musician is documented in his "Foundations to Flute Playing." This seminal method for flute instruction has been used for over 80 years to teach young flutists.








